



**VACATION, ADMISSION AND EXAMINATION SCHEDULE IN RESPECT
OF COLLEGES IN THE STATE for 2015-16**

For Semester System(1st year Class).....in phased manner....

The Semester System has been introduced in the Colleges of Himachal Pradesh from the 1st year of degree courses from the session 2013-14. In view of this, **the proposed admission/vacation/examination schedule for the academic session 2015-16** is as under:-

Admission Schedule

Sr.No.	Period	Days	Remarks
1.	11 th June to 20 th June	10days	Without late fee
2.	21 st June to 30 June	10 days	With late fee @ Rs. 10/- per day.
3.	Open House/ Counseling Sessions/Awareness Sessions	10 th June to till the closure of admissions.	
4.	It will be mandatory for every college to display time table giving all the details about Major/Minor/Elective subjects etc. in the 1 st week itself after the closure of all admissions i.e. 1 st July itself, so that the students can choose their minor/elective/GI&H subjects as per the time table and this week will be called as Zero Week.		

The regular teaching to classes of 1st Semester will commence from 21st June in every year. **To achieve 180 days of teaching throughout the year**, the teaching will be for 16 weeks in the 1st Semester from the date of regular teaching i.e. 21st June onwards. During the 4th week (i.e. last week) of October, 10 days will be for Practical Examination and 20 days for Theory Examinations of the 1st Semester.

Note:- 1st Semester to be of longer duration as to cover Extra Curricular Activities i.e. Sports, Cultural and Elections to student bodies.

1st Semester duration (i.e. June=1week, July=4weeks, Aug=4weeks, Sept.=4weeks, Oct=3 weeks
Total 16 weeks for 1st Semester)

Examination Schedule

During the 4th week (last week) of October, 10 days will be for Practical Examination and 20 days for Theory Examinations of the 1st Semester (**Ending in the third week of November.**)

Vacation Schedule

Sr. No.	Period	Days	Remarks
1. (Festival Break)	Two days before Diwali and maximum of thirteen days.	9 + 4days	In all Winter/ Summer closing colleges.

2nd Semester :- The regular teaching of 2nd Semester will commence from last week of November for 14 weeks. **14 weeks bifurcation for 2nd Semester (i)** (Nov=1week, Dec=4weeks,

Vacation Schedule

Sr. No.	Period	Days	Remarks
1.	1 st January to 31 st January	31days	In all Winter/Summer closing Colleges.

14 weeks bifurcation for 2nd Semester (ii) (Feb=4 weeks, March =4 weeks, April=1 week)

Examination Schedule for 2nd Semester

During the 2nd week of April, 10 days will be for Practical Examination and 20 days for Theory Examinations of the 2nd Semester followed till the 1st week of May.

Vacation Schedule

Sr. No.	Period	Days	Remarks
1.	20 th May to 9 th June	21 days	In all Winter/ Summer closing Colleges.

Note:- Admission is open for all students on Roll on Basis, who are otherwise eligible without waiting for the final result. **Roll on system means the student who has appeared in the 1st Semester will go to the 2nd Semester as per the schedule without waiting for the result of the 1st Semester. However, he/she will have to fulfill all the formalities laid down by the college authorities like filling up of the admission form, if any, and depositing the prescribed fees. This will help to start the regular teaching of 2nd Semester in time.**

Principal may ensure that there is no provision of admission as per university ordinance after 30th June of every year and as per Hon'ble High Court Decision, no admission will be given after the schedule. Principal concerned will be responsible for strict compliance of the admission schedule.
