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BY-LAWS OF OLD STUDENT'S ASSOCIATION

OF

GOVERNMENT COLLEGE NALAGARH

- a. Membership (Qualifications and Eligibility): An Ex-student of Government College, Nalagarh, since its inception 1973, irrespective of age, qualification and profession provided the applicant bears a good moral character, except bankrupt, lunatic and convict under any law:
- b. Expulsion: Any individual member shall cease to be its member, Any
 - (i) On his/her death.
 - (ii) If he/she is declared insolvent.
 - (iii) If he/she has been convicted of any criminal offence.
 - (iv) If he/she works against the interests of the society/association and disregard to the rules and regulations of the society. expresses any
 - (v) If he/she fails to pay the dues/subscription of the Association.
 - (vi) If he/she resigns from the membership of the association/Society.
- c. Membership: Enrolment fee for the membership will be Rs. 100/- only which shall be renewed every year if the member remit Rs. 100/- on or before 1st January of each calendar year. Provisions of the life membership exist if the member pays Rs. 1000/- in lump sum. Besides, registration fee of 100/- will be taken from each member of the association other than membership fee (once in life).
- d. Funds: The capital of the Society/Association shall be through.
 - Membership fee /Subscription fee or life membership.

Financial contributions from Donors and grant in aid from 11. public/Govt. Institutions. NOTARY PUBLIC

Souvenir-aids. 111.

- e. Operation of Funds: The funds will be utilized on the advice of the Executive Committee and shall be operated by any two of the three members authorized by the Association:
 - I. Secretary of the Association.
 - II. Treasurer of the Association.
 - III. Any other member authorized by the executive.
- f. Constitution of General Body: The general body of the Society/Association shall consist of the active members of the Society.
- g. **Financial Powers**: At a given time the respective powers of President and Secretary to spend money, provided it is passed by the executive body with justification.
- h. **Meetings:** The general body of the Society shall meet in the premises of Govt. College, Nalagarh, HP or any other public place or hotel. The frequency of the meeting will be-
 - General Body: It shall meet annually and preferably the meeting shall coincide with the annual function of the college. For these 10 days prior intimation through media/suitable communication shall be given.
 - II. Executive Body: It shall meet once in a quarter or as when required.
 - i. Quorum of the meetings:
 - a) General House: A minimum of 10 active members must be present.
 - j. Calling of Meetings: The President shall preside over all the meetings of General House and the Executive body. However to call the meeting of General House a notice of 10 days is a must. In case of emergent meetings the same can be called at any time at the request of 1/3rd of active members.

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- k. Presiding over the Meetings: In the absence of the President, the senior most Vice-President any senior member of the General House shall be elected by the general House to preside over the given meeting.
- I. Voting: In case of voting to arrive at any decision, every member of the General Body shall have one vote. Proxy shall not be allowed. All issues shall be decided by a majority of votes, when votes are equal, the chairperson of General Body shall have a casting vote.

m. Powers & duties of the General Body:

- I. Admission, suspension, election or removal of any elected or nominated member.
- II. Election of Executive Body.
- III. Amendment of rules.
- IV. All business discussed or decided by the General Body shall be recorded in the proceedings book which shall be signed by President of the meeting who so ever may be and maintained by the Secretary.

Executive Body:

- I. Constitution: The Executive-body of the Society shall consist of the elected amongst the members of the General body of the Society. The Executive body shall consist of the following office bearers.
 - i. President
 - ii. Sr. Vice President
 - iii. Vice President
 - iv. Secretary
 - v. Joint Secretary (Admin.)
 - vi. Joint Secretary (Press)
 - vii. Treasurer
 - viii. Co-opted Executive Members, if any.
- II. Term: The elected members of the Committee shall have a span of 2 year or till the times as the new Executive Committee is constituted by the General House Annual Meeting.
- III. Powers: The Executive body shall have full powers to take any decision.

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□ Duties of the Office Bearers:

- (i) President: He shall call and preside over the meeting Association.
- (ii) Vice-President: In the absence of the President, the senior most Vice-president shall preside over the meetings.
- (iii) Secretary / Joint Secretary: Secretary shall execute the decisions of the Executive Committee. In the absence of the Secretary, the joint Secretary shall assume his duties and powers.
- (iv) Treasurer: He shall maintain the proper accounts of Association.
- a. **Audit**: The Executive Committee shall nominate two persons to audit the accounts of the Association. The Annual audit report shall be placed in the Annual General House meeting of the Association.
- **b. Dissolution of the Association/Society**: General House of the Association with 2/3rd of active members can pass a resolution for dissolution of the Association. Association, if any, will be transferred to Government College, Nalagarh, HP.

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
