Analysis of strengths of various departments

After getting the information from various departments, the strengths included supportive students, highly qualified faculty, great participation in extra curricular activities, students' expertise in finance, accountancy, marketing skills, improvement in university results. Students are able to develop new skills and also make balance between theories. They have also become socially practical with the society. Some departments are taking initiatives to start PG course like mathematics. All subjects promotes critical analysis and there is active participation of faculty in different activities in and outside the college. Some departments conduct field survey which helps in developing various skills in respective subjects.

Analysis of weaknesses

Many departments are single faculty and thus are over burdened. Therefore field visits are not possible. There is less number of regular faculty in some departments. Subjects have more theoretical approach and less practical approach especially in humanities. There is non availability of subject books in library, and study material is insufficient. There is lack of lab facility in some departments.

Analysis of opportunities of various departments

The departments of college deliver quality education, helps in development of good leadership quality. It also helps in making career in law, teaching, research, NGOs, social work, as counselor. They also provide opportunities for competitive exams and develop

critical thinking. The education helps students in placement in various sectors like government, academia, industries, finance and marketing areas etc.

Analysis of challenges of various departments

The various challenges include improper teacher student ratio, insufficient infrastructure. There is need of more counseling sessions for students. There is need to focus on soft skills and professional development. Biggest challenge in the various subjects is need to shift from theory to more practical approach especially in humanities.

Recommendations

The recommendations from various departments highlighted shift of present department to new chemistry block. For further improvement feedback will be taken for the next session and geography department will try to prepare disaster management plan for the college. More visits to business houses and financial institutions will be organized by commerce department. There is need of more faculty to improve the teacher-Student ratio in some departments. Zoology department to develop well equipped zoology lab and separate smart class room. There is also urgent need to develop separate computer lab for mathematics students to practice mathematical languages such as C++, Mathematica, Matlab. There is need to encourage innovation and entrepreneurship. There must be regular curriculum review.

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
