

Analysis of strengths of various departments

Analysis of opportunities of various departments

Activities conducted by different departments leads to confidence building, public speaking and dealing which leads to development of good leadership quality. It also helps in making career in law, teaching, research, NGOS, social work, IT sector, media, music industry, research institutes, hotel industry, pharma industry, etc. They also provide opportunities for competitive exams and develop critical thinking.

Analysis of challenges of various departments

Recommendations

There is need to encourage innovation and entrepreneurship. There must be regular curriculum review. There is need to construct new classrooms over new chemistry block. Need of specialized faculty for PG classes.
