FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

We have set new standards and have reached new milestones during this academic year. The past year has been filled with challenges, achievements and growth, and I am thrilled to share the progress with all of you.



COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

Govt. College Nalagarh was established in the year 1973 and is one of the premier institutions in Himachal Pradesh. The prime objective of this college is to nurture and enlighten students. At present the college provides a variety of courses to the students such as B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., M.A(English), MA(Economics), M.A(Political Science) .M.Com., M.Sc(Chemistry), B.C.A., P.G.D.C.A. There also is an IGNOU centre and a Community College in the campus.

In the year 2024-25, the college took up some unique ventures: A Botanical Garden has been developed and a Shooting Range (second in all the State colleges) has been installed in the college where one State-Level Shooting event was organized .This range was inaugurated by Sh. Vikramaditya Singh, Hon'ble Minister, P.W.D. Govt. of H.P. The new complex has been taken over by the college from P.W.D. and the Library has been shifted to this complex. The Library and the auditorium have been stacked with new furniture. In addition, the Chemistry laboratory has also been shifted to the new building and is now functional.

One of the major additions that will be seen in the next year is the 15 crore Integrated Sports Complex to be constructed in G.C Nalagarh Campus for which the sanction letter has been already received.

BOTANICAL GARDEN ESTABLISHMENT IN SESSION 2024-25

The onset of the establishment of the botanical garden at Government College Nalagarh in the academic year 2024-25 stands as one of the most remarkable achievements of the institution. This significant milestone reflects the college's commitment to environmental sustainability, and holistic education. The botanical garden will serve as a living laboratory, offering students invaluable opportunity to study plant diversity, medicinal herbs, and ecological conservation . The garden will provide a hands-on learning experience for botany and environmental science students, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application. Additionally, it will serve as a tranquil space for students and faculty to reconnect with nature, fostering a deeper appreciation for the environment. This initiative underlines the college's dedication to green practices and sustainable development, making it a landmark accomplishment in this academic session.

CSCA ELECTIONS

College CSCA election for the academic session 2024-25 was conducted purely on merit basis prescribed by the Lingdoh Committee. Our college CSCA body consists of forty one nominated members. Among them four are office Bearers: Tanu Sharma, President (M.Sc.-1st Sem.), Kavita, Vice-President(B.Sc.-3rd Year), Disha, General Secretary (B.A 2nd Year) and Priya Devi, Joint Secretary(BCA-1st Semester) . Other thirty seven members are from different fields such as Academics, Sports, NCC, NSS, Cultural, Rover and Rangers, Red Ribbon Club and Eco Club.

ACADEMICS

BCA/PGDCA Department: Pioneering IT Education at Government College Nalagarh

Since its establishment in 2009, the BCA/PGDCA Department at Government College Nalagarh has been an integral part of the institution, dedicated to shaping the future of aspiring IT professionals. These self-financed programs were introduced to equip the students with the essential knowledge and skills required to excel in the ever-evolving field of computer applications. With a strong emphasis on practical learning and skill development, the department ensures that students receive hands-on experience alongside theoretical instruction. The college boasts a team of dedicated faculty members who play a pivotal role in delivering quality education and fostering a culture of innovation.

A testament to the department's expertise is the dynamic official college website; conceptualized, developed, and maintained by the BCA faculty. This initiative not only showcases the department's technical proficiency but also enhances GC Nalagarh's digital presence, making its academic and institutional journey accessible on the global stage. By empowering students with industry-relevant skills and fostering innovation, the BCA/PGDCA Department continues to be a driving force behind the success of its graduates in the IT sector.

BBA DEPARTMENT (Self-Finance)

Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) department under the self-finance scheme was established in the academic year 2021-22 with the objective of providing quality education in business and management. The program aims to equip students with essential managerial skills, leadership abilities, and industry-relevant knowledge to enhance their career prospects in the corporate world.

The first batch of 17 students successfully graduated in the academic session 2023-24, marking a significant milestone for the department. Currently, in the academic year 2024-25, the department has a total of 116 students enrolled in various three years: 50 in the first year, 26 in the second year, and 40 in the third year. With a dedicated faculty and a focus on holistic development, the BBA department continues to nurture young professionals, preparing them for dynamic business environments and entrepreneurial ventures.

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Community college was established under the UGC Scheme with a sanction of UGC grant of 1.25

crore in the academic year 2014-15. Till date 97 students have successfully completed Advanced diploma in Hospitality & Tourism. A total of 50 Students have been appointed in various hotels and tourism establishments till date. Rest are either pursuing higher studies or have established their own business. At present, the college is running on the self –financing basis with no other support from any other establishment or agency. In the current academic session 14 students have taken admission in certificate course in Hospitality and Tourism and 17 students have been admitted to Advanced Diploma in Hospitality and Tourism. An Entrepreneurship fair was organised in the month of Oct 2024 with BBA Department and 16 students participated in this fair.

The students were given a stipend in the range of Rs.2000/- to Rs.3000/- in addition to free boarding and Lodging facilities. The training is an essential part of the curriculum which enables the students to get a job in Hospitality and Tourism Industry.

The Students are assessed by Toursim and Hospitality Skill Council each year for each semester which is a mandatory part of the course.

INDIRA GANDHI NATIONAL OPEN UNIVERSITY (IGNOU) STUDY CENTRE-1157 SESSION: 2024-25.

- IGNOU is a leading university in the field of open learning and is recognized throughout the world. Its flexible system offers golden opportunities to people who wish to enhance their educational qualification along with their jobs.
- IGNOU, Study Centre -1157 was established at Government College Nalagarh in the year 2009. Initially the centre started with mere 4 programs and few students, but with every turning year

the strength of the centre has improved. Currently, Dr. Harvinder Singh is the coordinator of the IGNOU, Study Centre -1157. The strength of the centre has reached to 1420 and IGNOU Study Centre -1157 offers 29 different programs to suit the learners' need.

LIBRARY

- Library is the lifeline and integral part of any educational institution. The college has a well stocked library containing 16, 300 books. The college has subscribed six newspapers and two magazines.
- The college has already been connected with INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network Centre) . It is a UGC sponsored center that enables the college to share e-resources.
- In this session, the college library was shifted to Ground Floor of newly constructed Multipurpose Hall. The library facilities have now been are upgraded with Bar-Coding, RFID Tags, Easy Cataloging Soul -3.0 upgraded with latest version and both the Librarians of the College have obtained training on this.
- During this session, Library capacity has increased with the purchase of sixty chairs & tables.
- E-Journals and E-Books through N-List are available in the College library. Three Sets of computers along with printers and a Photocopier have been purchased through RUSA Fund.
- The library provides the use of workstation to student with internet facility. This facility is free of cost and helps students to access the latest updates in their subjects.
- One room has been made for the librarian.
- Smt. Bimla Sharma and Shashi Prabha both are Assistant Librarians of the College.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Various Central and State Sponsored Scholarships are allocated by the College for promoting educational and economic interest of weaker section and meritorious students. In the current academic session 2024-25, 94 students have received scholarship under various schemes like Post Matric Scholarship for students belonging to SC, ST, OBC and IRDP. For Meritorious Girls students, Kalpna Chawla Chakravarti Yojana has been introduced. Numerous Central and State Sponsored Scholarship schemes are advertised in the campus so that a large number of students get benefited from these schemes. The co-ordinator of the Scholarship committee is Prof. Sanjay Sharma.

SPORTS

Sports Achievements in the Academic Session 2024-25

This academic year saw GC Nalagarh students participate enthusiastically and achieve remarkable success in a variety of Inter-College sporting events. Our athletes demonstrated dedication, skill, and sportsmanship, bringing home a collection of medals and accolades. The following report details our participation and achievements across different disciplines:

- **Athletics:** Event organized in (GC Hamirpur, 13 -15 November, 2024) : Twelve students (5 girls, 7 boys) participated in this Athletic Meet. Shehanwaj (Captain) secured a bronze medal at the Inter College level, along with Praveen Biswal, Akash Prajapati, Akash, and Diksha Thakur who also won bronze medals. Disha Chandel added to the athletic achievements with a bronze medal in her individual event. Our 4x100m relay team, consisting of Shahnawaz, Akash,

CAREER COUNSELLING & PLACEMENT CELL

- Organised a Lecture on Career Guidance on 04th October 2024 in the Examination Hall in which Ms Ilma Afroz IPS, SP Baddi addressed 350 students.
- Certificate Courses' classes were conducted from December 9, 2024, to December 31, 2024 in Room No. 16 (Science Block) and Computer Lab in collaboration with NICE Foundation and Labournet Livelihood Foundation in which 60 students participated.
- A Placement Drive was conducted by Vardhman Textiles Ltd in the College Campus on December 13, 2024.

PM-USHA SCHEME

- A grant of 50 Lakh rupees was received under the scheme . With this money a new shooting range was established and the conference room was renovated .
- The grant was also used to purchase furniture for the library and auditorium. Computers were also purchased and digitization of the library was initiated.

OLD STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION

Old Student's Association (OSA) of Govt. College Nalagarh, Distt Solan HP, emerged in 2004 and was registered in 2019 . The OSA has been actively involved in the overall development of the college by organizing various activities of social and developmental nature under the dynamic leadership of our esteemed President Prof. Satwinder Singh. Right now the OSA is targeting the creation and development of an open stadium in front of basket ball court. The said project is partially funded by the aid of Rs. 3.0 lakh by Truck Union Nalagarh.

WOMEN CELL AND SPARSH
